

2021 SPRING CLEAN-UP

APRIL 12 - APRIL 16

Residents should utilize these dates to have the City of Fredonia pick up unwanted items. The City will remove unwanted-grouped items at no expense to the residents. The City will collect unwanted items on your normal trash day, beginning the morning of Monday, April 12th. It's important to have items out ahead of time. **Items that are placed out AFTER 7 AM on your normal trash day, will NOT be picked up.** Be mindful, the total collection of clean-up week can take the crew a couple of weeks, and will have set days for picking up certain grouped items, before rotating back through the town to pick up other categories of debris.

Items accepted during clean-up week are:

Appliances/E-waste:

(computers, scanners copiers, microwaves, washer/dryer, DVD/VCR players, dishwashers, water heaters)

Furniture

Scrap Metal

Yard Debris:

(limbs, leaves, brush)

Trash

Recyclables:

(#1 through #7 plastics, glass bottles & jars, newspapers, books, paper/junk mail, catalogs, phonebooks, cardboard, aluminum cans, steel cans, household/car/lawnmower batteries)

Used Oil: can be taken to and disposed of at the City Shop 1115 N 6th Street.

Dumpsters/Dump Trucks: Residents wishing to take advantage of a City dumpster, or City dump truck, at their residence must contact the City Shop 620-378-3161 ext. 1. Please leave your name and phone number for a call back to determine your need for a dumpster/dump truck. Dumpsters are recommended to remove excessive amounts of trash/unwanted items; while dump trucks are recommended for large amounts of limbs/yard debris, or construction material. **Only during clean-up week are dumpsters/dump trucks available to residents at no charge.**

Recycle Center 1312 N 2nd Street is available year-round for any resident wishing to drop off recyclables. Hours: Monday-Friday 7:00AM-4:00PM; 620-378-2208. An open building located east of the main recycle center is available for after hours.

TIRES: The City will **NOT** pick up unwanted tires

Residents can take tires to Wilson County Landfill; disposal fees will apply
