



City of Fredonia

The Federal Government, State, and Local Officials, will be working together with medical officials in the next several weeks in preparation to reopen the country if the COVID-19 impact peaks as expected in late-April. However, it is still critical that we remain vigilant in making sure to adhere to the KDHE's request of eliminating all non-essential travel and limiting gatherings to 10 people or less. Additionally, continue to practice social distancing (6 feet or more) and proper hand washing to minimize the risk of infection. Below are several quick updates for you to be aware of at this time:

- The CDC is encouraging everyone to wear a mask covering your nose and mouth when you are in public. There are many resources available that demonstrate how to make a mask using a t-shirt, handkerchief, or bandana.
- Our hospitals continue to request those who believe they are infected to call and speak with hospital staff before taking any further action.
- Our parks and public recreation areas continue to be open but the playground equipment is not in use.
- All food-preparing businesses are required to serve their food as carry-out or delivery. There is no in-restaurant dining under the current state mandates.
- The City of Fredonia will waive late fees on utility payments for the month of April. Customers are still responsible for paying their statement balance.

Finally, the City Commission held its second online meeting on Wednesday, April 15, 2020, and the meeting can be viewed on the City's website at www.fredoniaks.org or on the City of Fredonia's Facebook link.
