3. The site shall be covered with a minimum of two feet of soil graded to match the surrounding contours of the area.
4. Re-seed with vegetation compatible with the area and maintain until established.
5. Contaminated materials shall NOT be Disposed ON-SITE.

DEMOLITION SPECIFICATIONS

1. Owner or Contractor must contact Kansas 1-800-DIG SAFE (1-800-344-7233) before proceeding with any excavation.
2. The contractor will be responsible for obtaining permission from adjacent landowners if any vehicular or pedestrian traffic is required.
3. Disposal of all debris and building materials will be the contractor's responsibility.
4. Cement block, brick or rock foundation material may be used as fill in basement area if a minimum of twenty four (24) inches of soil is used to cover the entire basement. Dirt required for fill is the contractor's responsibility. All other decomposable type materials will be removed from site.
5. The contractor will cap sewer line at the main or other suitable location if sewer is a joint service, and will call Fredonia City Hall at (620)378-2546 to have the cap inspected.
6. The contractor will be responsible for notifying all utility suppliers so that they may make necessary disconnects.
7. Contractor will notify the City of Fredonia Code Enforcement Officer of dates of demolition.
8. The demolition site will be graded to allow proper drainage and accumulation of water.
9. An inspection of demolition site will be required for final approval.
10. Contractor will be given thirty (30) days to complete all work from the start date. If more time is needed, the contractor will notify Code Enforcement Officer before completion date has expired.
11. All nuisances will be removed from site and unsafe, wells, etc will be demolished, leveled, and or filled.
